**Matthew L. Graves, MD** currently serves as Professor, Trauma Fellowship Director, Hansjörg Wyss Endowed Chair of Orthopaedic Trauma, and Chairman of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery and Rehabilitation at the University of Mississippi Medical Center (UMMC). A native of Clarksdale, Mississippi, Dr Graves graduated summa cum laude from Vanderbilt University with a major in Honors Biology. Following graduation from medical school at UMMC in 2000, he continued there and completed his orthopaedic surgery residency.

Dr Graves completed an AO Trauma and Deformity Fellowship at Northern Nevada Medical Center and an Orthopaedic Trauma Fellowship at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle, Washington. He returned to UMMC in 2006 to join the Department of Orthopedic Surgery. Aside from clinical care, his primary focus has been education. He was the residency program director for 12 years, a long-time member of the Orthopaedic Trauma Association Education Committee and serves on multiple education task forces for AO Trauma. He is a four-time winner of the Ronald J. Kendig Orthopaedic Professor of the Year Award and a two-time recipient of the Howard Rosen Award and Visiting Professor of the Year Award. He has taught over 100 courses on trauma and deformity in 12 countries.
