After completing his Orthopaedic Residency at the Universidade Federal de São Paulo in 2003, Dr Raduan did two fellowships there, a Sports Medicine Fellowship (2004) and a Foot and Ankle Fellowship (2006).

He was a faculty member of the Orthopedic Department at the Federal University of São Paulo for 15 years before becoming the Head of the Foot and Ankle Group in the Sports Medicine Division., and then three years later, he was appointed Head of the Foot and Ankle Group in the Orthopedics Department from 2014-2016.

Dr Raduan's career always related to both, sports medicine and foot and ankle. He was the Head Physician of the Brazilian Beach Soccer National Team, and other professional basketball and water polo teams.

He is an International member of AOFAS, ESSKA, and a member of the Ankle Instability group. He has published several articles and book chapters in different journals and books about ankle instability, progressive collapsing foot deformity, plantar plate repair and others.
